

## Donor Recognition policy

### 1 Introduction

- 1.1 ARTIUM values the Donors who support its important work funding basic research in the arts, humanities, and culture sector, and recognizes the importance of of acknowledging their contributions.
- 1.2 This document sets out ARTIUM’s policy on how this acknowledgement occurs.
- 1.3 This policy should be read in conjunction with the Donation Acceptance policy and the Privacy Notice and GDPR Compliance policy.

### 2 Definitions. The following definitions are used in this policy:

**Donor** is any person who has made a monetary donation through the ARTIUM platform.

### 3 Policy, Procedures, and Enforcement

- 3.1 Unless anonymity is requested, all donations of whatever monetary value will be acknowledged by ARTIUM through publication of a list of Donors on its website.
- 3.2 This form of recognition and associated conditions described here are neither fixed nor exhaustive.
- 3.3 Prospective Donors are welcome to suggest variations.

### 4 Jurisdiction

- 4.1 This policy is governed by the laws of England and Wales. All matters relating to the policy are subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.
- 4.2 If any provision of this policy is found by a court or other legitimate body to be illegal, invalid, or unreasonable, it will not affect the remaining policy which will continue in force.

### 5 Equality, Diversity, and Inclusion

- 5.1 This policy has been designed to ensure that no one receives less favourable treatment due to protected characteristics.
